Both author's private papers and photos, and materials from "The Soviet consumer cooperatives", Tsentrosoyuz scientific theoretical and practical review. The report on the All-Union meeting was published in November 1983 issue.

The events of the meeting of young Soviet cooperators which took place in heroic Volgograd in 1983 are getting special relevance in 2015 declared "Year of Youth" in the Republic of Belarus especially since it's also 70th anniversary of Soviet people Victory in the Great Patriotic War.
